WHAT

A 9-month paid internship is available at the California Department of Public Health in Sacramento and Richmond. Internships are 29 hours a week during academic instruction. During academic breaks hours may be increased.

WHO CAN APPLY

For the internship starting in June 2020, the following students are eligible:

- Those who graduated in the Fall quarter or semester of 2019.
- Those who graduated in the winter or spring quarter or semester in 2020.
- Those who will graduate in the summer 2020 intercession.

AS A CSU INTERN

CDPH interns work on a wide range of activities. An intern may be immersed in one primary project, or their supervisor may choose to give them a variety of assignments.

Interns are also provided:

- 1. Ongoing CDPH training opportunities.
- 2. Regular check-in meetings.
- 3. CDPH Richmond campus/UC Berkeley trip.
- 4. "How to get a State Job" presentation by CDPH Human Resources.
- 5. Ongoing mock interviews & resume building.
- 6. Mentoring from supervisors, internship program alumni and CSU Public Health faculty.
- 7. Career planning information sessions.
- 8. Professional development coaching.
- 9. Promotion of graduate program opportunities.

HOUSING & TRANSPORTATION

Students will be responsible for making their own housing arrangements. CDPH will provide informational resources for relocation.

A Sacramento State ONECARD can be purchased for \$15 and a transportation pass for \$40. A Sacramento State ONECARD can be used at various locations for discounts.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Provide a 1-2 page letter of interest and a resume to your University's Public Health/Health Science department chair outlining why you are interested in the internship.
- 2. Your University's Public Health/Health Science department will forward their recommendations for the internship to CDPH.
- 3. CDPH will interview applicants and select interns.
- 4. Selected interns must be enrolled in an accredited college (ex: CSU/community colleges) and must maintain 6.0 units during the fall and spring semester to maintain program eligibility.
